- Not be under the influence of any substance that may increase the risk of injury while operating sharpening equipment and handling sharp tools.

What to bring:

- Your own tools / equipment to sharpen.
- Correct chainsaw round file, flat file & nut spanner.
- If you have them – battery powered grinder. (no corded tools please)
- Spare batteries and charger for batteries.
